



## **FREQUENTLY ASKED QUESTIONS & ANSWERS**

### **How long is the Clinical Practicum SPEAK OUT!® Course?**

The Clinical Practicum SPEAK OUT!® Course is the same length as our online SPEAK OUT!® course, which is offered for 1.0 ASHA CEUs. CEUs and therapy kits are not included with the free student course, though.

### **Are students allowed to take the Clinical Practicum SPEAK OUT!® Course at home?**

Absolutely! Students can complete the online course just like other SLPs who are taking our courses.

### **Are there any privacy issues that prevent students from viewing the videos at home on their computers?**

Students can use their personal computers, iPhones, iPads, etc. They should not be sharing the link with other friends, though. Free access to the student course is exclusively for students who are involved in a practicum with a grant site. We're using the honor system.

### **Do I have to wait until my colleagues have completed the online SPEAK OUT!® course in order to receive my SPEAK OUT!® Therapy Kit?**

Your therapy kit will be shipped to you upon completion of the course. You will not have to wait until your colleagues have completed the course. The other therapy supplies (e.g. LOUD Crowd® Workbooks) will be shipped once everyone in your clinic has completed the training. The deadline for the training is August 10<sup>th</sup>.

**What is the value of the grant?**

We do not yet have a total per person as we are still finalizing the expenses from the symposium, but we will share that information with grant recipients once we have that figure.
